MOTORCYCLE & ATV DRAG RACE

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO READ AND SIGN A WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK FORM AS PRESCRIBED BY THE BARBOUR COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION. ALL PARTICIPANTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 WILL ALSO NEED THE SIGNATURE OF A PARENT/GUARDIAN. THERE ARE **NO** EXCEPTIONS:

- All classes are subject to change to single elimination or be eliminated depending on the amount of participants.
- After the rider's meeting the participants and their numbers will be announced in each class over the public address system. We need to keep the area quiet. After the announcement, it is the participant's responsibility to make sure their name is announced in the correct class. We will give five minutes for any discrepancies to be brought to our attention so corrections can be made. After the races have started the line up CANNOT be changed.
- Trophies and/or plaques will be given to the top three (3) riders of each class.
- You must have pants that go below the knees and a helmet to participate.
- NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS of any kind are allowed on the event grounds.
- If any official feels that a rider may not be able to handle the machine, the rider may not be allowed to participate in an event.
- Speed limit on the grounds is limited to 5 mph. Speeding or horseplay is not allowed.
- Drivers have 2 minutes from the time they are called to report to the starting line.
- Before reporting to the line, drivers must be ready to run, if not you may be disqualified.
- No burnouts will be allowed.
- Jumping the starting line or crossing the center line will be a loss for that race.
- After finishing a race, riders must go immediately to the return lane unless they know they have lost 2 times.
- Speeds in the return lane will be kept low. Stunt riding (wheelies, stoppies, spinning, etc...) will not be tolerated in the return lane. Riders CAN & WILL be disqualified for inappropriate behavior in the return lane.
- No chains, studs, paddles (over 1" tall) or spikes are allowed in or on the tires. Paddles allowed in outlaw class only.
- Riding is only allowed between the pits and drag strip, once you leave the arena, you cannot return.
